Please do not use the abbreviation "SAAF" or "JLS." On first reference, please write *"John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation, a fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation."* On subsequent references, please use "John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation." When referencing the Area Foundation on subsequent mentions, please write, "Area Foundation."

Please use the following description for your grant: *"a grant from the John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation, a fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation"*.

Please use the following boilerplate for the "About the San Antonio Area Foundation" section of your media releases and other communications:

The San Antonio Area Foundation has served as the sole, designated community foundation for the San Antonio area for over half a century, growing to become one of the Top 20 foundations in the nation based on asset size. The Area Foundation helps donors achieve their charitable goals, managing more than 500 charitable funds approaching \$1 billion in assets. The **John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation** naming convention must be used in its entirety for signage and plaques. All signage must be approved by the Area Foundation’s COO before building application. If space constraints prohibit the use of John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation, please contact the Area Foundation’s COO for approved options.

On written advertisement: The John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation logo and/or credit must appear with wording as follows: *“a grant from the John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation, a fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation”*. Please do not use the abbreviation “SAAF.”

### Website and social media

You may include an announcement on your organization’s website and/or through social media regarding your grant. The John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation logo and/or credit must appear in all printed advertising with wording as follows: *“a grant from the John L. Santikos Charitable Foundation, a fund of the San Antonio Area Foundation”*. Please do not use the abbreviation “SAAF.”
