- In partnership with team, develops and implements a plan for increasing awareness
 of the Area Foundation among prospective advisors, including marketing collateral and
 events strategy.
- Actively seek opportunities for the Area Foundation to make community presentations and work closely with staff. Must be able to make presentations on behalf of the Area Foundation.
